Josiah (641-609) An eight-year old boy Reformer like Hezekiah / Torah Rediscovered Potential Messiah, Killed at Meggido Jeremiah Composed Laments

Jehoahaz (Three Months) Aka Shallum (1 Chron 3:15) 2 Kings 23:29-33 Neco deposes him

Jehoiakim (608-598) Neco sets up Jehoiakim

Babylonian Campaigns Begin (604-601)

Battle of Carchemish (605) Jehoiakim becomes vassal of Nebuchadnezzar (604) Jehoiakim's Fast (Jeremiah 36:8-31) Burning the scroll of Jeremiah In his days, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up, and Jehoiakim became his servant three years. Then he turned and rebelled against him. (2Ki 24:1) Jehoiakim rebels (601) Jeremiah's Prophecy of 70 Years (25:1-13) Babylonian Campaign (598) 2 Kings 24:6-7 Jehoiakim dies

Jehoiachin (598-597, three months) AKA Coniah, Jeconiah Jehoiachin takes throne (2 Kings 24:8) Jeremiah predicts exile (Jeremiah 22:24-30) Babylon besieges Jerusalem, king surrenders, deportation of nobility (2 Kings 24:10-16) King Jehoiachin's Exile (Ezekiel 1:2)

Zedekiah (596-568)

Nebuchadnezzar puts Zedekiah on Throne (2 Kings 24:17-20) The Conspiracy against Babylon (593 BCE) Hannaniah breaks Jeremiah's Yoke (Jer. 27-28) Zedekiah summoned to Babylon

Zedekiah Rebels (2 Kings 24:20-25:1) Pharaoh marches (Jer 37) Jeremiah calls for surrender (Jer 21) Dropped in a Cistern (Jer 38) Jeremiah buys a field (Jer 32) Zedekiah's Failed Escape (Jer 52:4-15)

Gedaliah appointed as governor (2 Kings 25:22-24) Jeremiah released (Jer 40) Assassination of Gedaliah (Jer 41) (Fast of Gedaliah, Tishrei 3)
