	Can be anonymous
	Recipient should know it's for Purim
	Recipient can use money to pay for Festive Meal
	Often distributed through an agent at the synagogue

Fast of Esther

Starting at dawn on the day leading up to Purim

Ends after the Megillah reading

Only for people in good health

Half Shekel

Three coins per family member

Half the basic denomination (half-dollar coins)

Given to the poor
